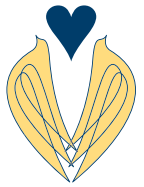

*Simply Worship is an opportunity for people with memory loss and their care partners to worship together in an environment that meets their unique needs.*

Simply Worship is a dementia friendly worship service. It enables persons with dementia to approach God, worship and praise him, and feel his caring presence.

Contents will include:

Old, favorite hymns and well-known Sunday School songs

Familiar liturgical pieces such as the Lord's Prayer and Apostles' Creed

Stories from scripture

A short Christian message

The services will be non-denominational and non-sacramental.

**Care partners must remain at the service with their participant to assist them as needed and share the experience with them. Participants cannot be dropped off for worship and picked up later.**

**Simply Worship is open to the public and will meet each Thursday morning at 10:30 a.m.**

The location will alternate between Holy Family Memorial Chapel and the Felician Village Blessed Angela Chapel based on this schedule:

**Second and Fourth Thursday of each month**

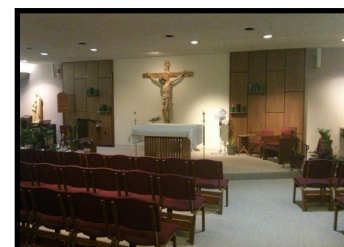
Both locations are wheelchair accessible, restrooms in close proximity & have a hearing loop system that benefits persons wearing hearing aids with a t-coil feature for improved clarity of speaker.

Dementia may interfere with a person's ability to connect with and to participate in traditional religious activities and worship styles that had been meaningful in the past. Yet persons with dementia continue to need to worship and experience a comforting, encounter with Christ. Meeting this need is the core purpose of Simply Worship.

Worship can be a channel for recalling the past, creating feelings of comfort, familiarity, and spiritual fulfillment. The music, singing, scripture, sermons, prayers, and rituals included in Simply Worship are designed to spark a faith-filled response to God in persons with dementia. Worshipers can experience and respond to the presence of God in their lives.
